Incoming Kindergarten	<i>Chicka Chicka Boom Boom</i> by Bill Martin, Jr., and John Archambault <i>Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?</i> By Bill Martin, Jr. <i>Green Eggs and Ham</i> by Dr. Seuss Nursery Rhymes and Fairy Tales Suggested Guided Reading Levels A-B. Scholastic.com is a good tool for leveled readers.
Incoming 1 st Grade	Suggested Guided Reading Levels C-D (should be reading easily with no more than 5 mistakes a page). Some students will be at Levels E-F. Scholastic.com is a good tool for leveled readers.
Incoming 2 nd Grade	Students should be reading chapter books. If not, continue with Leveled Readers. These chapter book series are suggested: 1) Calendar Mysteries; 2) Flat Stanley; 3) Cam Jansen; 4) Nancy Drew; 5) Magic Tree House
